## ANNEGRET SOLTAU PERSONAL IDENTITY

In occasion of Open Art Munich



Annegret Soltau (\*1946 in Lüneburg / Germany) dedicates herself to female identity, identity in general, the relation of body and space, and to the specific aesthetical examination of social conditioning.

During her studies at the Academy in Hamburg, in the late sixties and early seventies, with Hans Thiemann, Rudolf Hausner and David Hockney, a period of protest and rebellion, when academic rules and bondages were refused, the artist experimented with drawing and graphics. The line quickly became an expanding element and in spectacular performances Soltau embroils herself, others and the surrounding environment.

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A series of photos from these „knitting“ actions, graphic or physical and gestural elaborations, originates the following step of „oversewing“ self-portraits, a process that finally results in compositions of ruptured, recomposed and sewn photographic fragments. New portraits are thus constructed, mostly from real families and circling around their protagonists, an intimate and personal approach, but at the same time of general relevance and significance in relation to questions like personality, individuality, gender, change, and social codification. Similar transformations are visualized by Soltau in performances and video clips.

Demolition, reconstruction and a form of collage, not by glue, but by thread, dominate her procedures. What has been expressed by painters like Francis Bacon, Asger Jorn, Jean Dubuffet and others, namely the suggestion of a multiple nature, the metaphorical image of human oppression, the continuous research on life and being, a sort of reorganisation of things, all this is articulated by Soltau in the broken, destroyed and then „repaired“ pictures where contrasted surreal realities are meeting. As we can see in „N.Y. Faces“ (2001/2002) for instance, a group of works created in reaction to September 11th, where shock and sadness were frozen in open mouths. The works represent a combination of passport photos and a photographic documentation of a dentist's treatment. On the back are adjoined press messages from the concerning event. „Personal Identity“ (2003-2014) dedicates to the subject of our commonly certificated existence which can not be imagined without chipcards. The cycle „ZeitErfahrung“ contains nearly the complete oeuvre of the artist in smaller scale and will only be finished with her death.

After two presentations of Soltau in Italy – 2012 with a collective show entitled „CORPI SOLITARI. AUTOSCATTI CONTEMPORANEI“, curated by Giorgio Bonomi, and in 2013 with a personal show in Brescia – in 2015 we focus on certain essential aspects of the oeuvre with examples from the long term project „ZeitErfahrung“, from „Personal Identity“ and „N.Y. Faces“, as well as some examples from former periods with some selected works from „Selbst“.

Annegret Soltau will talk about work and life on the 1 October 2015.
