JUNWON JUNG THE PLACE OF MY WORK

Junwon Jung (b. 1978), the jewellery artist from South Korea, who was awarded the Herbert Hofmann Prize in 2019, chose the title of this exhibition of his latest works very consciously. THE PLACE OF MY WORK accurately describes the essence of his work, which revolves around questioning function, attribution, definition, location, space and content.

I am experimenting with the possibilities of ornaments as an independent and autonomous object through the process of repetition of dismantling and rejoining of the minimal structure and variable functionality. (Junwon Jung)

Junwon Jung examines contingencies and constraints. He plays with deferring one function to another, with the changed meanings which arise from each. He dismantles and reconstructs his elements that in principle act as jewellery but are equally able to mutate into an object, into a 'box', into a sculptural corpus; they are both, and much more besides. They imply a complex dialogue in a sphere that is yet to be re-calibrated. In doing so, the artist is beholden to an unpretentious geometric idiom developed from the subject matter. It is not his intention to overload his statement with colour or decoration, rather that it reflects a clear and decisive stance. And so his creations thus take their position in a universal, intercultural space, which they occupy and create themselves or which can be assigned to them.

Philosophy and artisanal bravura, artistic reasoning, sculptural sensibility and sensitive perception flow into impressively concise forms of rather slight dimensions. The jewellery is at the same time faced with metamorphoses that have accrued historically, for it could be a receptacle – of memories, of emotions, of found items or ritual material. This has partly become lost in our time. However, Junwon Jung is not so much interested in such a back story, although he is indirectly connected to it, but rather more in a conceptual transformation of aesthetic considerations that touch on the discourse of meaning and function, of space and corpus, of content and form, and that interpret them into the most precise objects. He hails from jewellery yet ultimately also works as a sculptor, as we know from, for example, Richard Serra or Eduardo Chillida – stringent, reduced, abstract, perhaps with an affinity for design.



And this prompts another question, that of the locus of the artist per se, of the contemporary artist, of the contemporary artistic forms of expression and vocabulary, which nevertheless leave the traditional terrain and celebrate self-evidently the paradigm shift. In a metaphorical sense, the works by Junwon Jung raise crucial topics and theses commensurate to the current debate and find in them once again an exciting and stimulating answer.
